A PROCLAMATION CENTRAL SERVICE WEEK

- WHEREAS: Central service technicians are responsible for processing surgical instruments, supplies, and equipment. Serving in settings ranging from hospitals to ambulatory surgical centers, central service technicians provide support to patient care services; and
- WHEREAS: Central Service Department tasks include decontaminating, cleaning, processing, assembling, sterilizing, storing, and distributing the medical devices and supplies needed for patient care; and
- WHEREAS: The Central Service Department of a health care facility is the heart of all activity surrounding instruments, supplies, and equipment required for operating rooms, endoscopy suites, an ICU, birth centers, and other patient care areas; and
- WHEREAS: Central service technicians play a most important role in patient care arenas and are responsible for first-line processes to prevent patient infections; and
- WHEREAS: Central Service Week affords us an opportunity to recognize the contribution central service technicians make to patient safety and the opportunities and challenges faced by those in the profession; now
- THEREFORE: I, NATHAN DEAL, Governor of the State of Georgia, do hereby proclaim October 13-19, 2013, as CENTRAL SERVICE WEEK in Georgia.
