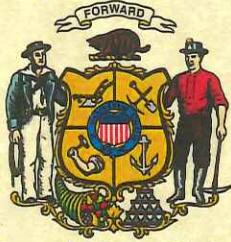

WHEREAS; Central Service Technicians play an important role in patient care arenas, and are responsible for first-line processes to prevent patient infections;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim October 11 – 17, 2015, as

CENTRAL SERVICE WEEK


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
